GROWER PRODUCER CHAMPAGNE

These champagnes tend to show minerality and complexity.

LEAN AND RACY

Usually from cooler regions, these wines all have refreshing acidity. Crisp, aromatic, and bright. Balancing citrus fruit and minerality notes. These wines are all about showcasing the purity of the fruit with little to no influence from oak. Perfect with seafood, or a great way to start a meal.

BRIGHT AND LIGHTLY CHILLED

Very lighter style of reds, perfect to be consumed in summer or during the day. Softer tannins, higher acid and lots of red fruit flavours. Try these wines slightly chilled to help express the freshness and pure fruit characters of these wines, a great way to consume red wine in our Australian climate.

MEDIUM BODIED AND STRUCTURED

Developed and richer style red wines, the use of oak should be now quite present. Moving into darker fruits spectrum, with even more spiced notes and savoury characters. Designed to be drunk with food and even some bottle age for further development. More pronounced tannins, and longer finished.
